	 The PC Bylaws that were approved by PC last month have been redirected for County Council to review. If any changes are suggested, they will be brought back to PC in April for approval again. 	
	 Making Parenting a Pleasure, our parenting curriculum, is being delivered via email this year. Each week a focus area is present over email, and activity is provided for parents to work on at home. Keep an eye out for these emails each Thursday. 	
	 Child Nutrition Unit recently surveyed the teaching staff to hear about food items from their culture they would like to see on the menu. The goal is to add diverse foods to the menu. Some of the suggested items included things like Chicken Tikka Masala, Chicken Adobo, Gumbo, tostadas, and so much more. The nutrition team will be reviewing these suggestions and working to incorporate them into the menu. 	
	 Our Health Content Manager is working with CCHP to organize vaccine distribution to our teaching staff. We are hopeful that by next week, interested teachers will have appointments for their first dose of the vaccine. The state recently provided new guidance on the age eligibility for children enrolled in state-funded preschool programs; this would be all our children with full-day services. Children born between 9/2/2016 - 12/1/2016 will enroll in TK this fall and not qualify for state-funded preschool programs. All our families have been contacted, and CS helped them register for TK at their local school district.
